## BLUE CARD UPDATES

### TOPIC 1: MWR Rec Rentals

**EXPLANATION/DISCUSSION:** Current policy requires service members to pay for extended days of rental fees when MWR is closed for holidays or weekends regardless of desired return date.

**PROPOSED RECOMMENDATION:** Service members should not be required to pay additional fees on days MWR is not open. (1) Make it a flat rate w/return due at next open hours of operation as MWR does at some other posts. (2) Make the policy generous and favorable to DoD ID holder patrons.

**RESPONSE:** MWR REC facility has made changes to the rental policy. Guests will not be charged for days when facility is closed.





## BLUE CARD UPDATES

### TOPIC 2: CYS Respite Hourly Childcare

**EXPLANATION/DISCUSSION:** It was approved in June to reintegrate Hourly Care Services on Ft. Hood. Four months later and after special inquires with Parent Central Services/CYS, specifically Mrs. Emily Perri, I cannot get an answer on when hourly services will start again.

**PROPOSED RECOMMENDATION:** Detailed proposed timeline. More specifically, what needs to happen in order to be able to open hourly care again and a detailed timeline of laying out the process.

**RESPONSE:** CYS Hourly care services were suspended due to COVID-19, IAW Appendix 1 (CYS Program COVID-19 Guidance) to Annex I of OPORD 21-061. The policy further states that when returning to HPCON Alpha, programs may reopen based on staffing capability levels and mission/community need, which at this time is full-day care and before/after school care.





## BLUE CARD UPDATES

**RESPONSE cont'd:** **CYS continues to work with the Civilian Personnel Advisory Center (CPAC) and is utilizing open continuous announcements for direct care positions, along with job fairs, to increase staffing levels. CYS is projecting to be appropriately staffed by the start of summer break and will resume hourly care no later than that time at Meadows Child Development Center.**

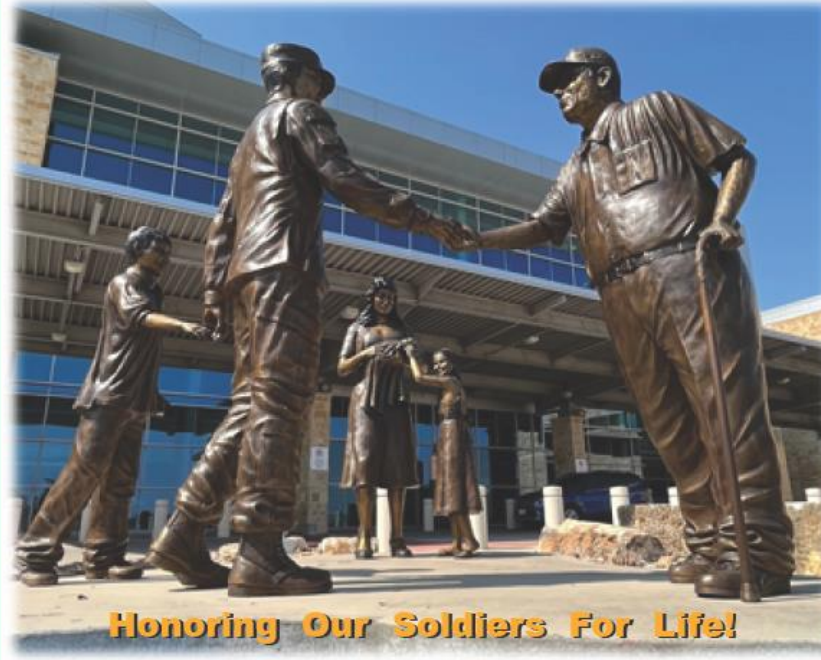

### Special Note:

Due to pediatric dosing guidelines children under 36 months should visit their Primary Care Manager for the flu vaccine.



Family Members and Retirees may obtain a flu shot at a TRICARE-authorized pharmacy or in network urgent care clinic. Beneficiaries are encouraged to check the policies and procedures of their preferred pharmacy prior to obtaining the vaccine. Some pharmacies require a prescription for children under seven years old and may not provide flu shots to children under 4. In such cases, parents can obtain a prescription from their primary care manager, visit a TRICARE network urgent care clinic, walk in to the CRDAMC pediatric clinic or attend any community or pediatric flu shot roundup.

## FIRE SAFETY

- **Know where your children will be going and who they will be with. Establish a route to be taken to and from their destination. Set time limits and check in times.**

## FORT HOOD MILITARY FAMILY MEMBER SCHOLARSHIP FUND

- **BACKGROUND:** The FHMFMFSF was established at Fort Hood in 1985. It is a 501(c)(3) private, non-profit organization under the supervision of the Garrison Commander. It was designed to be the focal point for all family member scholarship activities on Fort Hood.
- **MISSION:** The mission of the FHMFMFSF is to remove barriers to higher educational attainment and increase the quality of life of military families by providing academic scholarships to High Schools Seniors and Spouses of military members stationed at Fort Hood.
- Last year, we awarded a total of \$56,750 to 27 high school seniors and 1 spouse.
- Typically award amounts range from \$500 to \$5000, depending contributions received.

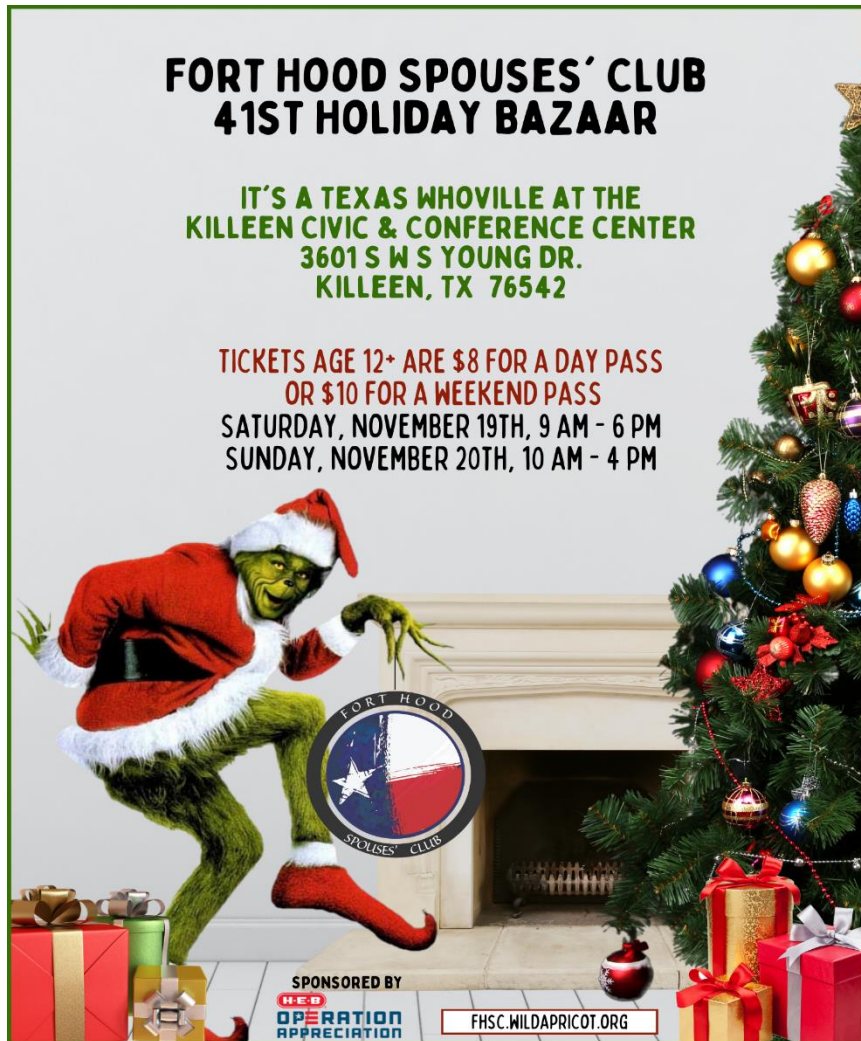
